

PURPOSE

To establish that the horse has acquired suppleness, impulsion and balance so as to be light in hand without resistance. While consistently accepting the bit, the horse exhibits greater use of the haunches throughout his movement. The rein back should show a greater degree of submission than at the Preliminary level. Lengthened trots to show engagement and development of frame. Introduction of collected trot. Progression in difficulty of movements with reins in one hand.
